







WARNING! African Swine Fever (ASF)


African Swine Fever is a disease that affect all swine and wild boars causing high mortality, leading to serious economic losses and trade blockages in pig farming and wild boar hunting sectors.

THIS DISEASE IS NOT TRANSMISSIBLE TO HUMANS

The African Swine Fever virus can be easily spread through contaminated meat products

Do not leave food waste available to wild boars.



Throw the food waste in the waste basket protected from any contact with wild animals.



If you are travelling outside Portugal do not bring with you pork and wild boar meat products.



When travelling, do not carry with you any pork and wild boar meat products.



Do not feed swine with food waste.

This practice is illegal.



Feed swine with appropriate feedstuffs in particular those from officially approved establishments.

In case of suspicion of African Swine Fever in swine or wild boar, you must immediately contact DGAV or ICNF
